You should always attempt to get your Form W-2, Form W-2c, or Form 1099-R from your employer or payer before contacting the IRS or filing Form 4852. If you do not receive the missing or corrected form from your employer or payer by the end of February, you may call the IRS at 1-800-829-1040 for assistance. You must provide your name, address (including ZIP code), phone number, social security number, and dates of employment. You must also provide your employer's or payer's name, address (including ZIP code), and phone number. The IRS will contact your employer or payer and request the missing form. The IRS will also send you a Form 4852. If you don't receive the missing form in sufficient time to file your income tax return timely, you may use the Form 4852 that the IRS sent you.

If you received an incorrect Form W-2 or Form 1099-R, you should always attempt to have your employer or payor lesúe a corrected form before filing Form 4852.

Note: Retain a copy of Form 4852 for your records. To help protect your social security benefits, keep a copy of Form 4852 until you begin receiving social security benefits, just in case there is a question about your work record and/or earnings in a particular year. Will I need to amend my return? You are responsible for filling your income tax return with accurate information regardless of whether you receive a Form W-2. You are responsible for filing your income tax return with accurate information regardless of whether you receive a Form W-2, Form W-2c, or Form 1099-R and regardless of whether the information on any forms received is correct.

Penalties. The IRS will challenge the claims of individuals who attempt to avoid or evade their federal tax liability by using Form 4852 in a manner other than as prescribed. Potential penalties for the improper use of Form 4862 include:
