Please find enclosed the original filing of my 2005 1040EZ Return. Please note that I have enclosed an attached 4852 corrected W-2 form properly documented, due to the fact that my company provided a W-2 which erroneously alleged payments of Internal Revenue Code sections 3121 & 3401 wages that are hereby disputed.

They have listed payments as "wages" as defined in the Internal Revenue Code Sections 3401(a) and 3121(a). I am rebutting their claim, stating that I am a private-sector citizen (non-federal employee) employed by a private-sector company (non-federal entity) as defined in 3401(c)(d). I am not employed in a "trade or business" nor am I an "officer of a corporation" The amounts listed as withheld on the W-2 are correct, however.

I expect a full and complete refund within 30 days on my 2005 return as dictated in the Internal Revenue Code Sec. 6402(a), 26 CFR Sec. 301.6402-3(a) (1) (5), and Sec. 6401(b)(c).
