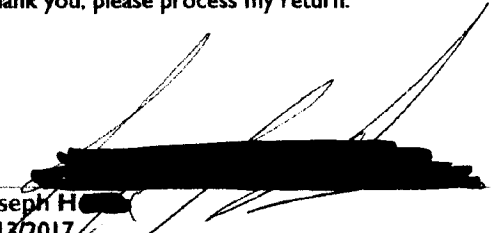
Dear Unknown Agent,

This letter is in reference to CP 13 dated June 19, 2017. In your letter you stated that you believe there is a miscalculation on my 1040EZ resulting in no payments made and no tax owed. In the above mentioned letter you also stated a denial of federal income tax withheld on page 2 of my tax return, because form(s) W-2 or other supporting documents were not attached to the tax return.

On Apr. 22, 2017 I sent a letter, see attachment, to Mr. Dierfield in your Fresno CA office as a response to the same information you are saying that you do not have. As such I am resending a copy of the 4852 form that was submitted and an edited copy of my check stub information (Supporting Documents). The information edited from that check stub was the pay information so as not to be misconstrued as 3401a wages or 3121a wages.

I assumed that as per the instructions on the 4852 form that it was sufficient information to process the return, if not please explain to me what other forms I might send in response to an erroneous W-2. I've already tried to have the company issue a corrected W-2 but they incorrectly assume that they paid 3401a wages and 3121a wages.
