We received your reply on Apr. 21, 2020, to our notice about proposed changes to some of the items on your tax return.

If you received a Notice of Deficiency, this letter doesn't extend the period of time you have to file a petition, if you choose to, with the United States Tax Court. The last day for filing a petition with the United States Tax Court is in the Notice of Deficiency.

Before we can resolve this matter, we need to process all of your information. We'll send you our complete response within 60 days. We don't need any further information from you right now.

If you think you might owe any additional tax, you should consider paying it now. The law requires us to charge interest on unpaid tax from the due date of the return (not including any extension of time to file the return) to the date you pay the tax in full.
